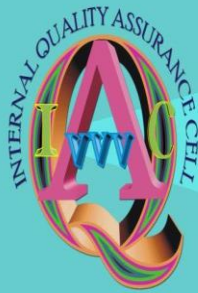

## ABOUT OUR COLLEGE

V.V.Vanniaperumal College for Women was established in 1962 in Virudhunagar, Tamilnadu by the unanimous efforts of the elders of the town with the great objective of imparting higher education to the women folk in and around Virudhunagar and thereby uplifting their status in the society. Ever since its inception with 15 teachers and 84 students on its roll with only pre-university courses and minimum facilities, the institution has grown by leaps and bounds in its fifty one years of dedicated valuable service to the society. This year, the institution has many achievements to its credit and has added new feathers to its cap.

An autonomous institution affiliated to Madurai Kamaraj University, the institution was accredited with 'A' Grade by NAAC and re-accredited with 'A' Grade with CGPA of 3.24 on four point scale in 2010. It offers academic programmes both in regular and self-financing streams – 24 undergraduate programmes, 13 post graduate programmes, 4 M.Phil. programmes and 2 Ph.D., programmes, UGC Career - Oriented Add-on Courses on Functional and Communicative English and Diploma in Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics and certain Certificate and Diploma courses are also offered to the stakeholders. Partnership with IGNOU under Convergence Scheme enables the institution to offer dual degree programmes. The department of History is awaiting the approval of the commission to deem the department of History as Research Centre.

The institution has spacious classrooms, State-of-the Art Laboratories, A/c Conference Halls with LCD Projectors, Digitized Library with excellent learning resources, Internet Facility, Hi-tech English Language Lab, Commerce Lab, a capacious Multipurpose Hall, automatic uninterrupted power supply and in-campus hostel facility and bus facility. The well-qualified teachers periodically update their knowledge by pursuing research-oriented activities. The sincere dedication and strenuous endeavour of the non-teaching staff are assets to the growth of the institution. The curriculum is well-designed to cater to the needs of its

stakeholders. Conferences, workshops and seminars are regularly organised to promote research culture. The students are encouraged to participate in curricular, co-curricular and extracurricular activities conducted at all levels.

The institution is the consistent recipient of the Best Women's College Award in the Youth Festival conducted by Madurai Kamaraj University. It has consistently produced good results in the summative examinations. By hosting tournaments it enhances the sportive spirit and calibre of the students. To create a sense of selflessness and service – mindedness among students, service forums such as NSS, Extension Service, Social Service League, Youth Red Cross and Red Ribbon Club function regularly. Placement Cell arranges in-campus interviews and off-campus interviews and a considerable number of students get placed in reputed companies every year. Low achievers are taken care of by organizing remedial and coaching classes and financially weak students are supported with aid generated from all possible means. Ward-Tutor system and Parent-Teachers' Association strengthen the relationship among students, parents and teachers and enable healthy interaction among them for the welfare of the students. Health awareness programmes have become a regular feature of the activities of the college for the well-being of the students. The democratic and transparent functioning of the Managing Board promotes the quality of the educational service offered by the institution to the society.

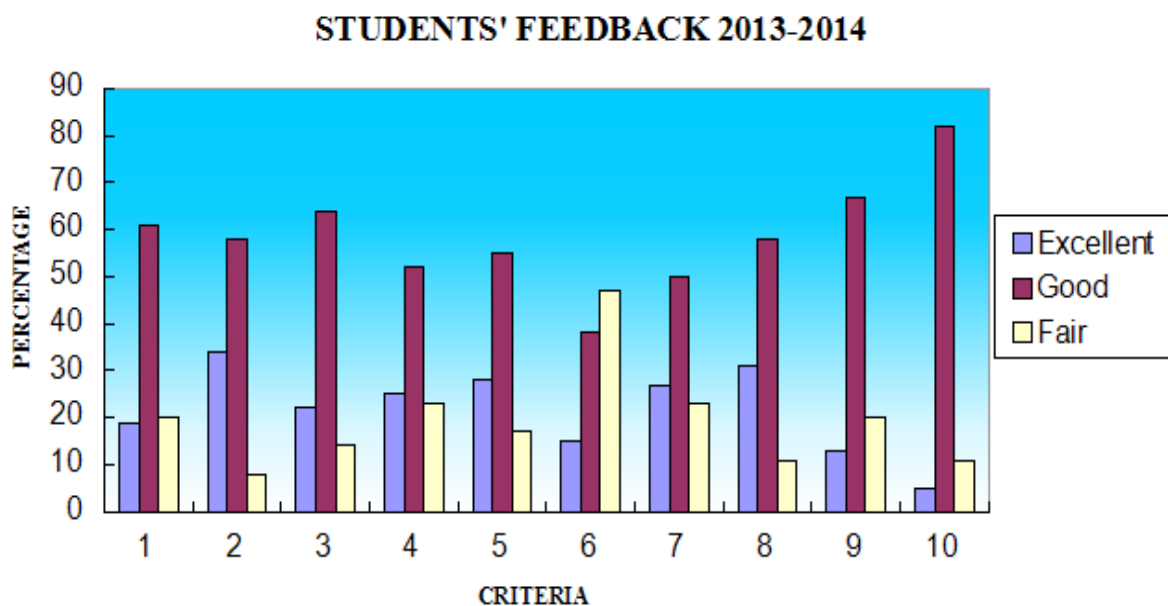

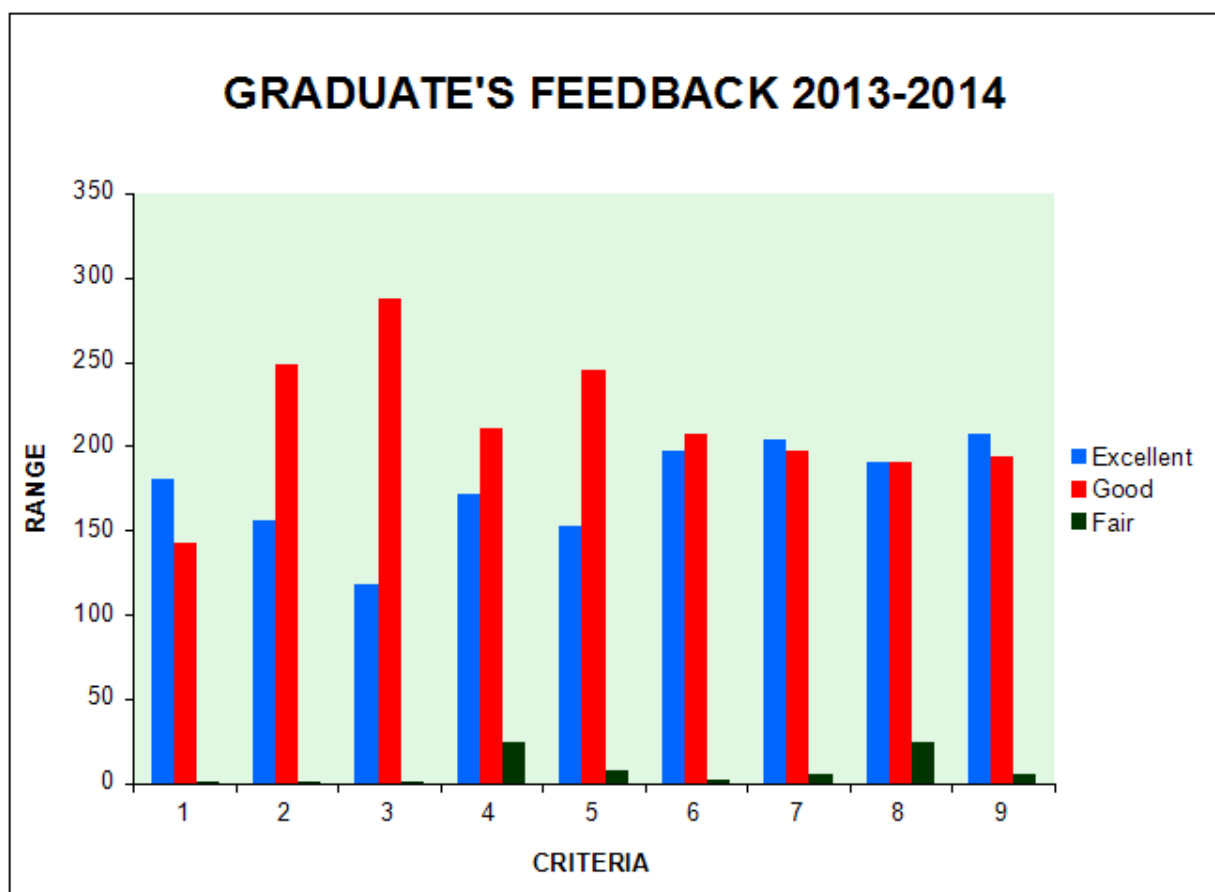
